Chief Minister's Message



To my people of Manipur,

Khurumjari!

The 2017 assembly election was a watershed moment in the political history of Manipur as it marked the dawn of a glorious future for the people of the state under the BJP Government. In the last 5 years, the BJP government of the state under the guidance of Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji has left no stone unturned to work for the peace, stability and prosperity of the state. The Government has brought development across all spectrums. People from all age groups, caste and ethnicities have benefitted from the Government policies. The last 5 years of Government has etched an indelible mark in the growth story of Manipur. We have moved away from the insurgency and have adopted inclusiveness. The BJP government of the state has set the bedrock for peace, stability, development and prosperity of the state and the state of Manipur today shines as the crown jewel of India.

The present day Manipur is a new 'Aspirational Manipur' where people are filled with hope for a better tomorrow. However, we should never forget the trauma which the people of the state had to go through during the regime of previous Governments. Before our Government came to power in 2017, blockade and bloodshed paralysed the development of the state. Widespread violence and insurgency proved to be a major roadblock for the well being of the people. Things have changed dramatically after the BJP formed the Government in 2017. After 2017, our Government worked with a single point focus of bringing peace and stability in the state. 1039 militants have enrolled under the Surrender cum Rehabilitation of Militants scheme and MOU has been signed with various Insurgent groups, thus Peace and Stability is restored in Manipur. We have brought development to the remotest parts of the state. We have worked for the well being of all people of Manipur irrespective of their caste, creed, tribe and race. We have done away with the politics of Hill and valley and focussed on bridging the gap between the people.

Since 2017, the Government of Manipur has worked on various initiatives for inclusive development in the state. Initiatives such as Go to Hills and Go to Village have seen overwhelming support across communities. Under the Go To Village programme 3,06,028 beneficiaries have been enrolled and 2,17,051 benefits and services delivered at their doorstep in all the 2,691 villages of the state. The policies of the Government have focussed on the overall development of the state. From incentivising trade and commerce to providing our youth with startup opportunities the Government has provided a safe environment for the dreams of the people to thrive. 5477 Startups have been supported under Startup India with a total cost of ₹114.56 Crore. There also has been extensive work for women empowerment. Ima Markets

at 10 more locations are constructed. Also, for women safety, we have established a Women Police Station in every district. Agriculture was also a priority for the Government. The State Government has launched a mobile rural mart and handed over mobile vans to three Farmer Producer Organisations (FPOs) and launched 11 FPOs in command areas of Thoubal Multipurpose Project. A total of 625 Farmer Interest Group (FIGs) in the field of Horticulture comprising 20-25 farmers each have been formed to facilitate organic farming on a cluster basis.

Under the visionary leadership of Shri Narendra Modi Ji, we are providing the benefits of various centre-sponsored schemes such as Ayushman Bharat, Ujjwala Yojana, Jal Jeevan Mission, PM Awas Yojana, and many more at the grassroots level. 61,884 houses were constructed under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Gramin - 8,349, Urban - 53,537) and the state is one of the top 10 states in the physical completion of houses. A total of 369 roads and 33 bridges were constructed with a length of 4971 km. The state has achieved 100% electrification under various centrally sponsored schemes such as Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana (DDUGJY) and SAUBHAGYA. Under "Chief Minister-gi Hakshelgi Tengbang" (CMHT) and Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PMJAY), 8.09 Lakh beneficiaries are enrolled and 1.1 lakh beneficiaries have received free treatment worth ₹123 Crore. 1.55 Lakh families have received free LPG connections under the Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana. Under the Jal Jeevan Mission, the households with tap connections have increased from 5.7% to 63.7% within 2.5 years. This is what a 'double-engine' growth of the government's policy does for a state. Our long-standing demand for an Inner Line Permit to preserve our heritage and culture has also been fulfilled by the Hon'ble Prime Minister. For the first time in the history of our state, we are connected to the railway map of India.

Our eyes are now on the next five years of growth and development. The idea is to develop Manipur as a model state. 'Model Manipur' will be based on the vision of the Hon'ble PM Narendra Modi Ji. In the coming five years we will see prosperity reaching all corners of Manipur. The policies of the state will no longer be about creating divides based on geography and ethnicity. In the next five years, the state is expected to make rapid strides towards 'Model Manipur'. Manipur is going to witness major growth in trade and commerce. The rail and road connectivity will be improved across the state and Manipur will serve as the 'Gateway of Trade and Commerce' to the South East Asian countries. Police welfare and modernization

Economic and social empowerment

- We will provide 2 free LPG cylinders annually to all the PM Ujjwala beneficiaries of the state
- We will establish Ima Canteens to be run by women in urban wards and market places in all the districts to provide subsidised nutritious food at the rate ₹5 per meal
- We will launch Women Entrepreneurship Scheme with the corpus of ₹100 Crore to help women become economically independent by:
 - O Providing a financial subsidy of up to 15% of the project cost to women entrepreneurs under the Stand-Up India Scheme
 - O Providing interest-free loans of upto ₹1 Lakh and collateral free loans up to ₹10 Lakh to women entrepreneurs
- We will establish a Self Reliance Women Cell under the Stand-Up India Scheme to provide technical, business development assistance and market access to women entrepreneurs
- We will establish women hostels in each district with all facilities for female students and working women

Gender empowerment

 Celebrating the 75th year of Indian Independence, we will launch the Rani Gaidinliu Nupi Maheiroi Singi Scheme under which girls from the EWS and backward sections will be provided with an incentive of ₹25,000. Under this scheme, girls will receive periodic financial assistance as follows:

- o Class 6 ₹3,000
- o Class 9 ₹5,000
- o Class 11 ₹6,000
- o Class 12 ₹11,000
- We will launch Nupi Maheiroi Yokhatpa Scheme to make women of Manipur self-reliant by providing a free scooty to all meritorious college going girls in the state
- We will provide financial assistance to meritorious female students pursuing higher education in private institutions
- We will provide free and quality education to all female students from KG to PG

Ensuring women safety

- We will ensure adequate participation of women in the police force
- We will increase the number of women police stations in every district as per the requirement
- We will set up a dedicated Women desk in every police station to tackle crimes against women
- We will establish Women Help Centers at each sub-division for rehabilitation and counseling of sexual assault victims
- We will further promote the 24 hours toll-free helpline number 181 to provide assistance to women affected by violence
- We will establish fast-track courts at every sub-division to expedite the resolution of cases related to women's safety and POCSO
- We will provide Special Guidance and Training Package to re-orient the State Police Force on issues related to Sexual Harassment and Domestic Violence
- We will introduce martial arts lessons for girl students in all elementary and high schools

Women health care

- We will achieve 100% institutional delivery to ensure that all pregnant women in the state have access to quality healthcare
- We will ensure 100% implementation of PM Matru Vandana Yojana to provide monetary benefit to all pregnant and lactating mothers
- We will install 10,000 sanitary napkin vending machines across the state in schools, colleges, market places and government institutions to provide sanitary napkins at ₹1 per piece
- We will provide a corpus to ensure mission mode construction of 1,000 public toilets with adequate facilities for women
- We are committed to improve the status of Anganwadi and Asha workers/helpers by:
 - o Increasing monthly honorarium by ₹1,000 for Anganwadi and Asha Workers and ₹500 for helpers
 - Providing Smartphones to Anganwadi and Asha workers
 - O Providing retirement benefits of up to ₹1.5 Lakh to Anganwadi and Asha workers



Empowering Youth - Education, Employment and Sports

Ensuring quality education

- We will provide free laptops to meritorious students of class 12 to pursue higher education
- We will launch a 'Back to School' Program to spread awareness and bring back children who
 have dropped out of education due to COVID-19 and other reasons
- We will extend the School Fagathansi Mission to revamp the educational infrastructure in all schools to:
 - O Refurbish, repair and beautify all the school buildings and equip them with clean drinking water, electricity and toilet facilities and develop playgrounds and recreational centers
 - Ensure the provision of state-of-art computer and science laboratories and audio visual projectors
 - O Initiate programs to establish at least one state-of-art smart classroom for every school and college in the state, to enable every student in Manipur to learn from the best teachers in the country
 - O Ensure online availability of study/resource materials to every student in the model of MOOC (Massive Open Online Courses) at school, college and university level. Towards this goal, we will create online recording facilities for teachers equipped with modern learning-teaching tools
 - Leverage Information Technology tools to ensure access to quality and affordable education for all the students. An <u>online learning tool platform</u> for Classes I to XII, apart from tools for assisting students for competitive Entrance Examinations for Medical and Engineering studies will be launched
 - Institute vocational training centres in all schools and provide internship opportunities

- We are committed to make Manipur the educational hub in the Northeastern states and ASEAN region. In the next 5 years, we will:
 - Revamp Government colleges with provisions for all streams and provide state-of-art facilities
 - Establish new polytechnic institutes and ITIs to impart technical education to youth
- We will initiate a Student Loan Program under which collateral free education loans of upto ₹2 Lakh at a minimum rate will be provided to EWS and backward section students from Manipur pursuing technical/engineering degrees in top Indian Technology Institutes/ Engineering Colleges
- We will establish career counselling centres in colleges. Additionally, we will also introduce a dedicated helpline for the students

Employment opportunities and youth welfare


- We will establish a ₹100 crore Start-Up Manipur Fund to provide zero-interest loans of up to ₹25 Lakh
- We will further invest in establishing a network of BPOs across the state to create local employment opportunities
- We will expand the network of Kaushal Kendras by establishing them in each block to impart skills to more than 2 lakh youth over the next 5 years
- We will establish the Manipur Skill University for skilling the youth of Manipur in sectors such as tourism, aviation, trade and commerce, IT skills, Mass Communication among others
- As a part of the Skill India initiative and to further leverage the goodwill of Manipuri youth garnered over the years in the hospitality sector, the State Government will work towards establishing a Hospitality Training Institute for further developing the soft skills necessary for the hospitality industry

Robust sports infrastructure

- We will work towards the overall improvement of Sport infrastructure in Manipur.
- We will upgrade the Khuman Lampak Sport Complex and Training center with world class sport facilities and a residential campus
- We will establish a world class Football stadium in Imphal and make it eligible to host international level football tournaments
- We will constitute a ₹10 Crore Manipur Football Revival Fund to nurture and revamp the historic legacy of football in the state
- We will promote hockey in the state by establishing Hockey turf in all the districts under Khelo India
- We will establish Mini-gyms and upgrade sports infrastructure in all schools, colleges and community parks
- We will establish a district sports complex in all the new districts of Manipur with the state-of-art sporting facilities, tracks, equipments and swimming pools
- We will expedite the construction of 'Manipur Olympian Park' as a tribute to all the Manipuri sportspersons who have represented the state at the international stage with distinction
- We will upgrade the Water sports complex at Takmu, Loktak lake and promote water sports in the state

Promotion of indegneous sports

Farmer first policy

- We are committed to doubling the income of farmers of Manipur. We will increase the financial assistance under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi Yojana for all the farmers from ₹6,000 to ₹8,000 annually
- We are committed to making Manipur Atmanirbhar in essential agricultural produce such as rice, poultry, dairy and horticulture products within the next 5 years by deploying technology, financial and administrative incentives among others
- We will ensure 100% coverage of Kisan Credit Card Scheme to provide short-term agriculture loans of up to ₹1 Lakh at a zero interest rate
- We will establish 150 Farmers Producer Organisation (FPOs) in the state by 2025. We will aim
 to generate more than 1 Lakh jobs through the Horticulture sector
- We will ensure that all interested farmers receive pension benefits of ₹3,000 per month under the PM Kisan Maandhan Yojana
- We will provide scholarships to children of small and marginal farmers and landless farmers pursuing technical education at the graduation and post graduation level

Right price for each grain

- We will introduce a Market Access Scheme for farmers to facilitate market information, transportation of produce and marketing
- We will introduce a Guaranteed Buy-Back Scheme for certain quantities of local Agriculture/ Horticulture products
- We will implement a Market Intervention Scheme for perishable horticulture crops to ensure remunerative prices for the farmers

Boosting agricultural produce and robust agri-infrastructure

- We are committed to invest around ₹5,000 Crore to improve the productivity of the farm sector
- We will provide additional subsidies for Urea and other fertilizers based on requirement to ensure that all the farmers in the state have access to required fertilizers before harvesting season
- We will establish a network of cold storage chains in all the major agricultural districts such as Thoubal, Bishnupur, Churachandpur, Tamenglong, Senapati and Chandel among others
- We will establish a state-of-art agriculture marketing complex with cold storage, warehousing, sorting and packaging facilities in all the districts of Manipur
- We will establish farm equipment leasing centers in all the agricultural districts by 2024

Ensuring irrigation facilities

- To improve the irrigation facility, we will construct check dams on all major rivers across the state
- We will constitute the Water (Jal) Ministry by merging all the irrigation related departments such as Water resource department, Minor irrigation and CADA under a new ministry to ensure a focussed push in development of irrigation facilities
- We will initiate new irrigation projects and complete ongoing projects in a time bound manner to make Manipur one of the highest irrigated state tapping into the abundant rainfall in the state

Welfare of fishermen and promotion of pisciculture

- We will ensure to make Manipur self-reliant in fish production by doubling production of fish
- We will provide free of cost accidental insurance cover of upto ₹5 Lakh for all fishermen in the state
- We will set up a fish processing plant at Bishnupur district and aim to boost fish products in the state
- We will promote eco-friendly boats and modern fishing equipments at Loktak lake for the welfare of fishermen
- We will promote hygienic retail fish outlets with state-of-art facilities in markets across Manipur
- We will establish an Inland Fishery Institute near Loktak lake to promote research and development in fisheries in the state

Horticulture

- We will establish a Bamboo technology Research Institute for extensive research on cultivation and utilisation of bamboo in order to promote bamboo products
- We will establish micro-processing units for orange, pineapple, lemon, kiwi and other high-value exotic fruits through targeted support to local entrepreneurs
- We will ensure the export of locally produced flowers such as Orchids, Premulas, Lilies, Rose, Gerbera etc across India and abroad in collaboration with major logistics companies

Animal husbandry

- We will establish a Veterinary college cum hospital in Manipur and a Veterinary Medical Clinic in each district. Additionally, we will establish mobile veterinary clinic in each block
- We will make Manipur a self-sufficient state in the production of poultry, piggery and egg production
- We will promote the production of animal feeds in the state and ensure self reliance in animal feed production by 2025
- We will provide infrastructural support and technical guidance for piggery, and cattle farming activities to all the local farmers of the state
- We will develop piggery development policy under the aegis of the Animal Husbandry department to make Manipur a 'Pork Hub' with a focus on producing export quality processed pork from the region. Andro, Phayeng, Kakching and Sekmai among others



Organic farming

- We will promote chemical free natural farming in the state
- We will introduce GOBAR-Dhan Scheme (Galvanising Organic Bio-Agro Resources) to generate energy and also augment income of farmers by converting cattle dung and solid agricultural waste into compost and biogas
- We will develop organic produce zones within the state agricultural market complex for collection, aggregation, value addition, processing, storage and market-linkages



Good Governance-Key to Prosperity

Effective governance

- We will launch the Aspirational Block Programme for the overall development in selected blocks based on the aspirational district programme of the Central Government
- In line with our initiatives of Go to Hills and Go to Village, we will further endeavour to
 provide all the Central and State government welfare schemes at the doorsteps of all the
 citizens in the state
- We will revamp the revenue collection system through a de novo (starting afresh) approach to
 ensure that Manipur becomes self-sufficient in the next 10 years and create revenue surplus
 in the next 15 years
- We will implement a Dashboard Based Monitoring System which will encapsulate decisions taken by various departments, will have set deadlines for implementing the decisions, and track progress made on implementation by assigned officials
- We will establish an Online Grievance Redressal Platform dedicated to the filing of grievances online by the residents. Grievances registered in this online platform will be addressed in a time bound manner by dedicated officials of respective Ministries
- We will establish a Citizen Service Centre, under the PPP model, in every sub-division of Manipur which will enable filing for various services provided by the Government of Manipur
- We will continue conducting Cabinet meetings in all districts of Manipur
- We are committed to make Manipur the leading state amongst the north eastern states in achieving the Sustainable Development Goals
- We will create empowered committees to closely monitor the progress across the Sustainable Development Goals. These Committees will submit their specific recommendations in a time bound manner for due consideration by the Chief Minister and his Cabinet for implementation
- With a view to enhance e-governance we will digitalise all government offices to ensure accessibility to all the services even to the remotest areas of the state



Economic and Industrial Development

Economic growth

- We will expedite our efforts to make Manipur the largest state economy among the North Eastern states
- We are committed to work towards doubling the state's per capita income in the next 5 years by ushering all round development of Manipur
- We will establish Invest Manipur along the lines of Invest India to provide transparent, unified, one-stop solutions for investors
- We will set a target to achieve first rank in the EoDB ranking list among the North Eastern states

Industrial infrastructure

- We will set up two Special Economic Zones (SEZ), one in Pallel, Kakching district and another in Jiribam district of Manipur to ensure economic development and provide employment opportunities
- We will establish a dedicated land bank for industrial development in the state
- We will establish a Transit Hub in specific districts to map Manipur as India's Gate-way to ASEAN countries

Focussed industries

- We will formulate a Special Industry Policy for Medium and Small Enterprises to serve the MSME Sector. Units operating in sectors, which already have certain base in Manipur, will be considered under this Industry Policy
- We will provide interest-free loans to MSME for technology upgradation, capital requirements and to enable better market access
- We will set up a Startup fund for entrepreneurs to promote traditional arts, silk weaving, sculpting and painting among others
- We will promote EXIM for a rough-and-ready market at Moreh border, allowing local people to trade locally-grown agricultural and manufactured items in designated border haats
- We will complete the construction of the mega Handloom cluster and handicraft village at Nongpok Kakching and Moirang
- All offices of the Government of Manipur will be directed to procure Manipuri handloom/ handicrafts, for use in the offices of the State Government and other Ministerial Offices.
 A separate procurement policy to facilitate procurement of Manipuri handicrafts by various government offices will be formulated

Mipal tangdaba Manipur

- We will introduce a One Sub Division One Product Scheme to promote indegenous produce from the state:
 - O A product from each sub-division within a district in Manipur shall be identified either from agriculture/horticulture/floriculture for promotion and up-scaling of production, with a view to supplying outside the state or export to the international market with emphasis on value addition of the identified products
 - O Seed funds for the creation of promotion councils for each product line shall be made available
 - Local products such as Ginger, Pineapple, Bamboo Shoots, Kachai Lemon among others will be promoted under the scheme to further provide employment opportunities to the people of Manipur
 - Create an open source marketing platform to showcase these products



Robust Infrastructure

Rural development

- We are committed to connect every village with the main road by expediting the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana
- We will embark on a mission to develop all the villages of the state on the lines of Smart village with all modern facilities including access to 100% piped water supply, road connectivity, pucca houses with uninterrupted electricity, bio toilets, high-speed internet connectivity
- We will incentivize banks to set up one branch with an ATM machine per gram panchayat to ensure complete financial inclusion
- To ensure better economic integration between the hills and the valley, model ultra modern Super-Markets facilities will be established in the Foot Hill Zones like Keithelmanbi of NH 37, Sanakeithel, Lamlai of Imphal, Ukhrul, Pallel, Morch among others
- Border villages will be developed under the Vibrant Border Village program wherein we
 will ensure the development of border roads, construction of village infrastructure and
 implementation of central and state schemes

Urban development

- We will expedite the various developmental projects across the cities under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) scheme
- We are committed to complete the North East Gas Grid Project to provide gas pipeline connection to the citizens of Imphal. Additionally, we will also work with the Central Government to setup gas pipelines to other cities of the state
- We will complete the establishment of the first ever LPG refilling and bottling plant to ensure regular LPG supply in the state

Ensuring basic amenities

- We will ensure 100% coverage of the PM Awas Yojana by providing a roof over every head in Manipur
- We will provide affordable modern housing options to people from low and middle-income groups by extending subsidised loans of upto ₹25 Lakh
- We will ensure the provision of clean piped drinking water to every household under the Jal Jeevan Mission
- We will provide uninterrupted electricity supply to all households in the state
- We will incentivize the installation of solar panels in houses, colonies, offices and factories

Robust road network

- We will complete the following projects in a time bound manner:
 - O Imphal-Tamenglong-Haflong-Guwahati National Highway
 - Four laning of Imphal-Jiribam road
 - Four laning of Imphal-Moirang State Highway
 - Widening of Imphal-Kakching State Highway
 - Upgradation of the road from Kangpokpi to Tamei and Tamei to Kuilong
 - 46 km Imphal ring road, 25 km Imphal elevated highway project by 2025

Railways

- We will introduce a FO-FO train (Follow Foothills train), a peripheral rail network along the foothills of the state which shall provide a panoramic view of the Imphal valley, the Iconic Loktak lake, the majestic mountain ranges and thus shall be a major tourism attraction, create job opportunities and improve the economy of the region. The network shall further connect all the major populated areas at the foothills of the Manipur valley and will also serve as the urban bypass and focus on the development of the standard of living of the rural areas and their productivity
- We will work in collaboration with the Central government to complete the construction of the world's tallest pier bridge in Manipur which is a part of 111 km long Jiribam-Imphal railway project
- We will work in collaboration with the Central government to extend 111 km long Jiribam-Imphal railway project up to the border town of Moreh
- We will expeditiously complete the construction of Imphal railway station by 2022
- We will work in collaboration with the Central government to initiate connectivity between Imphal and other major destinations in the country

Airways

- We will expand the infrastructure of Imphal International Airport to make it the largest airport in the North East and provide connectivity to the rest of the world
- We will push for the timely completion of the Imphal international airport terminal building by 2023. We will work with the central government to build frequent air connectivity with Southeast Asian countries
- We will introduce Helicopter service to the hill districts like Senapati, Tengnoupal, Ukhrul, Pherzwal, Churachandpur (Tipaimukh, Parbung and Thanlon) among others



Public transport

- To provide ease in travel to the residents of the state, Manipur state bus transport will be revived with the induction of 60 new buses in a phase-wise manner
- Mobile applications for booking bus tickets and smart bus dashboards will be installed to track real-time movement of buses in the state



Health for All

Quality and affordable health

- We will ensure 100% coverage of Ayushman Bharat and CMHT (Chief Ministergi Hakchelgi Tenbang) scheme to provide health insurance of ₹5 Lakh to all the eligible beneficiaries
- We will establish Ayushman Bharat Health and Wellness Centres across the state that will
 provide essential drugs and diagnostic services for free

Health infrastructure

- We will collaborate with the Central Government to establish AIIMS (All India Institute of Medical Science) in Manipur
- We will upgrade the status of RIMS, Imphal to ensure availability of the best healthcare services
- We will establish Multispeciality hospitals to provide quality health services to the residents
- Utilising Manipur's rich natural flora with medicinal value, we will establish the AYUSH
 Research Center at Keirao to undertake research and propagate commercial plantations of
 locally available medicinal plants. This Centre will also lead to the creation of clusters,
 including processing units, promote production, processing and value addition of AYUSH
 products from locally endemic flora of the state
- We will establish a specialised Cancer Treatment Centre in the state
- We will establish a Neuroscience hospital with 50 beds



- We will ensure every block has a Community Health Centre with an attached Jan Aushadhi Kendra
- We will ensure every gram panchayat has a Primary Health Centre with an attached essential diagnostic services laboratory
- We will introduce a network of 100 new ambulances and upgrade the existing fleet of ambulances in the state
- Additionally, we will introduce a <u>network of 100 bike ambulances</u> for better access to health services in rural and hill areas

Medical personnel

- We will fill existing vacancies for doctors, nurses, lab technicians and paramedical staff on priority
- We will increase the number of undergraduate and postgraduate medical and nursing seats by 30% in the state

Welfare of ex-servicemen

- We will establish Manipur Purva Sainik Kalyan Nigam to provide employment opportunities to the ex-servicemen including their children and widows
- We will provide reservation for ex-servicemen (ESM) in Group A and B category as per the central government norms
- We will increase the ex-gratia amount given to the dependents of martyred Soldiers to ₹10 Lakh
- We will expedite the construction of houses for the ex-servicemen. We will also provide special rebates in property tax and other municipal taxes for ex-servicemen

- We will provide up to 50% subsidy for assistive devices such as wheelchairs, prosthetic devices, orthotic devices and hearing aids

and Schedule Castes)

Welfare of unorganised workers

- We will establish a Hawker Cell to enable seamless registration and to provide any legal support required

World class tourism infrastructure and other facilities

- We are committed to position Manipur as one of the top tourist destinations in the North East. We will organise roadshows in metro cities and selected foreign destinations to display magnificent culture of Manipur and promote tourism
- We will ensure a doubling of international tourist arrivals in the state and also aim at tripling the number of domestic tourist arrivals
- We will establish a Manipur Tourist information Centre at Imphal as a tourist facilitation centre and one-stop for all the tour operators, tour guides and all other stakeholders
- We will set up a Homestay corpus to provide tax subsidies and cash incentives to homestay owners. Additionally, we will provide a single-window mechanism for registration of Homestay in the state
- We will introduce Manipur Tourism Skill Mission to provide training and employment opportunities to 1 Lakh local youth



Focussed tourism approach

- To promote internal weekend tourism in the state, we will endeavour to create tourism clusters
 which will be designed to engross the visitor with specific and curated activities. To promote
 tourism in border areas, we envisages pursuing the creation of tax-free shopping zones in
 Border Haats (to be created along the international border)
- We will identify Special Tourism Areas for the purpose of redevelopment, renovation and reinvention
- We will develop Ethnic Tourism circuits connecting various folk art forms, attires, cuisines of the people of Manipur will be the centrepiece
- We will initiate the Loktak Mega eco-tourism project to promote overall tourism in the state
- We will promote adventure tourism and trekking camps in the hill ranges of Manipur. We will
 construct a tourist facilitation centre, road connectivity and other basic facilities at Dzukou
 valley, Senapati district to boost tourism in the state
- We will initiate World war II Heritage circuit through the identification and connecting of world war II heritage sites and developing infrastructure and world-class facilities at these sites
- We are committed to establishing Manipur as a hub of medical tourism for the South East Asian region. We will establish a Medical tourism agency to streamline medical tourism and handle all aspects of a foreign patient's availing of health services in Manipur
- We will promote Manipuri Thali and other indigenous food and dining experiences across the country



Environment Conservation and Preservation

Environment conservation

- We will ensure the protection and preservation of rich and unique natural resources of Manipur
- We will strictly monitor illegal felling of trees in all protected forest, reserve forest and open forest

- We will convert Champu Khangpok floating village at Loktak Lake to Heritage floating village to conserve and promote the local heritage
